All set to go to the June Membership Picnic? We'll have a wonderful time. Isn't it always great—getting together with our families, relatives and friends?



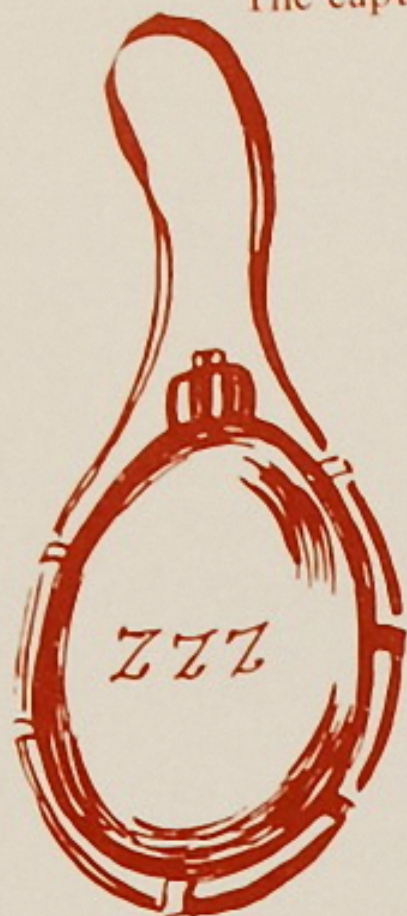

During this function, our President will make the presentation of the Club's \$250.00 donation to the Basque Studies Center, a research project and program that has accomplished so much!

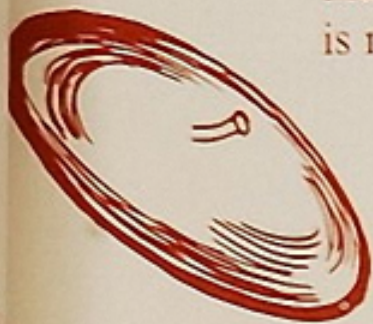
NEWS BRIEFS:

Frances Jacobsen, former owner of Pro-Serv, where the Club's printing is done, passed away—she was always so very pleasant and helpful—know she is missed by many!

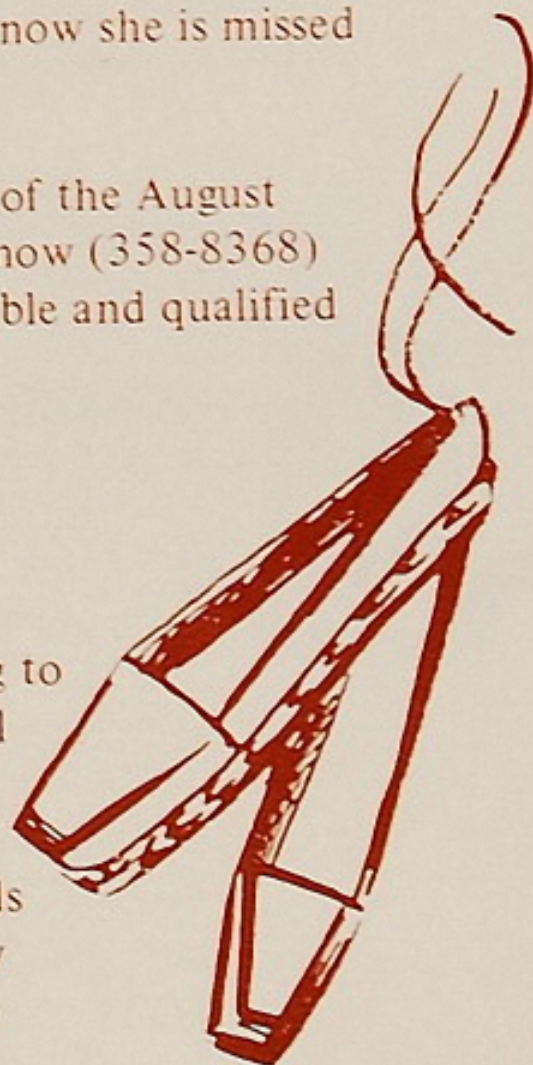
